THE CHAPLIN THEATRE

Documentary, directed by Zoran Krema 50' / Croatia / 2014

The documentary film The Chaplin Theater Tragicomedy In Four Parts - speaks about a group of young Roma under the leadership of Naser Sokoli who have decided to establish the first amateur Roma theater in Europe, possibly even in the world.

SNAJKA TRAZI SRECU (BRIDE LOOKING FOR HAPPINESS)

Documentary, directed by Tea Vidovic 17' / Croatia / 2014

A couple that gets married after eight months of relationship begin to encounter issues they've never thought about before. Will they go over their values in order to keep the family happy or will they try to seek ways to keep everybody happy?

MANGAVA DISCO PUNK

Short Fiction, by Saša Staniši 18' / Macedonia / 2013

Mangava Disco Punk (Romany for "I love disco punk") is the only punk rock band in the famous Macedonian gypsy ghetto Shutka. Their frontman Elivis unsuccessfully tries to conquer the heart of a waitress at the local restaurant.

CELIA STOJKA

Ceijka Stojka is a portrait of 64-year-old Austrian Roma Ceija Stojka who, after a nomadic childhood, settled in Vienna many years ago. Beginning with her present life, her biography is reconstructed in this film

In this beautifully told and stylish road movie, Roma radio reporter Orhan Galjus travels along with filmmaker Bob Entrop through German and Poland to his native Kosovo to reveal a truth of history - the Roma Holocaust.

Documentary, directed by Arian Mustafa 35' / Kosovo / 2014

It's a stark reality that Roma, Ashkali and Egyptians in Kosovo live on average 10 years less than the majority community. This investigative documentary takes us on a journey with Rahim as he seeks to understand why he, his friends and his family will live shorter lives than their neighbors.
